Anne Louise Harrison was born in Halifax on December 19, 1966. Daughter of Arnold and Betty Harrison, she attended Acadia Street Elementary School from Grade 1 to 5 and R. B. Dickey Elementary School for Grade 6. She then attended St. Charles and Amherst Regional High Schools. She was an honours student and participated in track and field, volleyball, band, and choir. She was also involved in various student council committees.

She was chosen senior princess and Miss Friendship for Winter Carnival 1984. She was a member of the Kool-Aid-Kids at the Amherst Shore and had a keen interest in the welfare of others.

Anne died on July 17, 1984 after a lengthy illness.
